2010-2011 MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

All Middle School Students

- Flash drive (2GB or larger) for transporting digital files (*labeled with student's name*)
- Back-up supply of printer ink and paper for home printers (to help avoid those last minute printer emergencies)
- 1 inch binder with 5 dividers for Portfolio (only for incoming 6th graders or new students)
- Sneakers and Active Wear for PE

6th Grade

- Five 1.5 inch binders (green-science, red-math, blue-English, white-history, different color of your choice for Latin)
- loose-leaf paper (50 pages per binder; no paper needed for math binder)
- PENCILS – lots of them! (wooden or mechanical), Erasers (caps and “Magic Rub” type)
- Pencil case to carry to class; Pencil container for the locker
- Locker shelf
- Spell checker (optional)
- At least 400 3x5 index cards
- 1 *extra large* “sock” book cover for math text
- 1 small protractor
- 4 highlighters
- TI-30XIIS calculator (or equivalent) with student's name clearly marked
- Rubber boots for the pond

7th Grade

- One 1 inch binder; Two 1.5 inch binders; One 2 inch binder
- 42 dividers total (12 for math, 12 for science, 12 for Geography, 6 for English)
- standard lined paper in each binder (50 pages per binder; no paper needed for math binder)
- 3 book covers (including 2 *extra-large* covers for math and geography texts)
- pen/pencil case – equipped with many pencils and pens (black or blue ink)
- eraser and eraser caps, hole reinforcers and ruler
- set of highlighters and Sharpie markers
- 100 3x5 index cards
- TI-30XIIS calculator (or equivalent) with student's name clearly marked
- 1 green pocket folder and 1 green composition book (lined paper-not graph paper, not spiral bound) for Spanish.
- 1 red pocket folder and 1 red composition book (lined paper-not graph paper, not spiral bound) for French.

8th Grade World Languages

- 1 red pocket folder and 1 red composition book (lined paper - not graph paper, not spiral bound) for Spanish.

8th and 9th Grade Science

- Sturdy 1.5 inch binder with dividers to keep notes, homework, handouts, etc.

8th and 9th Grade English

- Ample supply of highlighters and sticky notes
- 1 pocket folder for quizzes, handouts, etc
- A 1 inch binder

8th and 9th Grade Mathematics

- 1 sturdy 1.5 inch D-ring binder (the sturdier the better, no zipper, please)
- 12 dividers for binder
- Mechanical Pencils with spare lead, erasers
- TI-84 Plus or TI-84 Plus Silver Edition graphing calculator (available at Staples, Office Max, BJ's, etc.).
- A back-up four-pack of AAA batteries for the calculator
- 1 *extra-large* book sock

8th and 9th Grade History

- Sturdy binder with several dividers to hold handouts, homework, tests, etc.
- Loose-leaf lined paper
- Package of at least 100 index cards for research projects – 3x5 or larger
- 1 plastic accordion file for organizing research materials

- 1 blue pocket folder and 1 blue composition book (lined paper - not graph paper, not spiral bound) for Spanish
- 1 green pocket folder and 1 green composition book (lined paper-not graph paper, not spiral bound) for French.
